<b>Spiritual</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Encouraging children to reflect on their own lives and the lives of others as they learn about other cultures and traditions.</li><li>• We promote the desire to enjoy challenges when learning Spanish, showing qualities of persistence and resilience.</li><li>• MFL teaching fosters self-confidence and self-esteem, encouraging children to value and respect their own efforts and achievements and those of others.</li></ul>
<b>Moral</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Encouraging children to express themselves and communicate with others in another language.</li><li>• MFL provides opportunities for children to explore and reflect upon other cultures and to discuss moral issues relating to the society in which they live and other societies.</li></ul>
<b>Social</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Encouraging and teaching children the skills necessary to work together and co-operate, both in English and in Spanish.</li><li>• Develop the children's understanding of the positive impact of language learning and how it can impact on their lives and future aspirations.</li></ul>
<b>Cultural</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Enriching and extending our children's knowledge and understanding of other cultures and traditions in the Hispanic speaking world.</li><li>• Teach respect for other cultures and make links between our own culture and other cultures, while learning about and celebrating differences.</li><li>• To promote a desire to communicate in another language, thereby creating links through language.</li></ul>

### British Values in MFL

<b>Democracy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Encouraging children to consider the views of others in shared activities and realise that all viewpoints are valid.</li><li>• Help children come to understand that voting for outcomes is a valid and fair system</li></ul>
<b>Rule of Law</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Developing understanding of safe practices and class room and school boundaries, following class rules during projects and activities for the benefit of all.</li><li>• Children will understand the consequences if rules are not followed</li></ul>
<b>Individual Liberty</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children will be given opportunities to express themselves and their opinions through talk and practical activities.</li><li>• Children will work within boundaries in MFL while being encouraged to consider and make decisions.</li></ul>
<b>Tolerance of those with different Faiths and Beliefs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Opportunities to learn about, experience and talk about different cultures, traditions and religious beliefs.</li><li>• Children will learn about language and culture in a global context and will be encouraged to respect these.</li><li>• We will ensure that children hear and discuss unbiased and uncritical viewpoints of other faiths and beliefs.</li></ul>
<b>Mutual Respect</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Expectation that all children to behave appropriately, allowing all participants the opportunity to work effectively and to express their own opinions and views.</li><li>• Children will work together on projects, help and advise others and will review each other's work respectfully</li><li>• They will experience and learn to appreciate different cultures, festivals, traditions and celebrations through MFL.</li></ul>
