Due to GDPR we are unable to give out lists of class names.



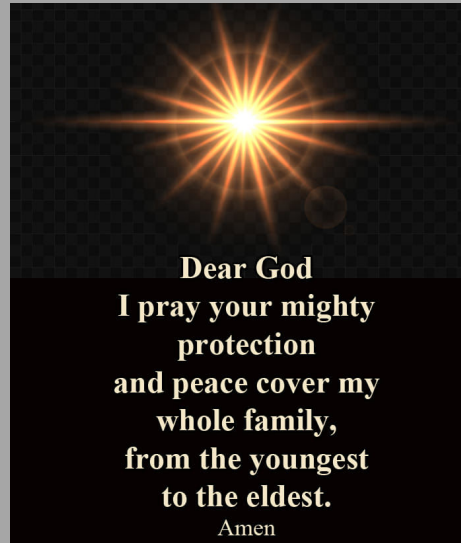
