Sun cream should applied before school.

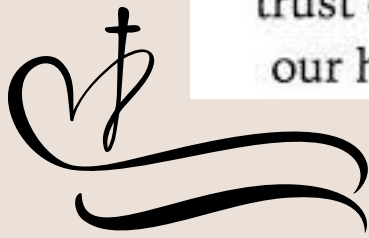


Truthfulness is this half term's Christian Value.
