It has been fantastic to see how proud the children have been coming into school wearing their new uniforms.

All children are supplied with all of the stationary that they need in school. Children in Key Stage 2 have all been provided with their own school pencil case and all the stationary needed for this year. The children may only use their own stationary during a wet playtime.

A range of important information will be shared this week at the "Meet the Teacher" events which will then be put on on our website and shared via seesaw for those who are unable to attend or if wish to refer back to it.

Key dates for the term will also be shared by the end of the week. We are working hard to ensure we continue to offer the children a wide range of trips and experiences that enhance the curriculum whilst continuing to only ask for minimal donations from parents to help finance these.

Last year we managed to ensure that all in school experiences had the costs covered by the school and that for trips no more than a £5 donation was requested from parents despite the average trip costing £22 per child.

Our plan is to do the same this academic year however due to rising costs we have altered some trips and experiences, this will not have a negative impact on our planned curriculum.

I look forward to getting to know all of our new families and continuing to work with our returning families to ensure every child succeeds during their time here at Hale CE.
